

## RELENTLESS YOUTH OUTREACH **PROGRAM**



The **Relentless** Youth Outreach Program is a program developed in partnership with the Edmonton Police Service that effectively addresses the unique needs of the highest risk young people in the City of Edmonton. The program offers a non-traditional approach that offers Relentless outreach, diversion from the traditional justice system, and customized individual interventions.

Edmonton's most criminally active youth have not had the same start in life as mainstream youth and therefore have complex needs.

High-risk youth may have unpredictable living conditions and struggle with mental health disorders. High-risk youth are more likely to engage in various criminal activities like gangs and drug culture, and at the same time are at increased risk of being victims of violence and exploitation. They may have been violated sexually, physically and/or emotionally. They often live with family members who have multi-generational involvement with police and social systems. They require an extensive amount of enhanced and **Relentless** support and assistance than what is currently being provided through the youth criminal justice system.

YOUCAN Youth Services Relentless Youth Outreach Program aims to reduce criminal activity and victimization impacting youth through our High-Risk Youth Relentless Outreach services to Edmonton youth. The foundation of YOUCAN Youth Services work is to create positive relational opportunities through outreach that supports high-risk youth to live out of harm's way. Some areas that our outreach services address are homelessness, education, employment, court-support, addictions, and mental health. A pillar of our work is engaging youth through transformational relationships creating a felt sense of belonging while advocating for youth to successfully navigate the complexity of issues impacting their lives.

#### RELENTLESS YOUTH OUTREACH PROGRAM 2022/2023 HIGHLIGHTS

72 youth participated in the program from April 1st, 2022 to March 31st, 2023

61 of 72 youth consistently engaged with their Relentless Youth Worker

**42** youth participated in Employment or Education Opportunities

**20** youth were assisted with residential placements or permanent housing

**24** youth were registered in treatment or stabilization services

**48** youth supported in justice system (lawyer, court, or probation officer)

**22** youth were supported with mental health assistance

Calculating Police data for the 72-youth participating in the program showed the following results in 2022 and the first three months of 2023 compared to 2021.

> All occurrences 45% decrease

All violations 46% decrease

**Violence violations** 47.9% decrease

**Property violations** 40.9% decrease

Victimization complaints 36.2% decrease

**Breaches/warrants Issued** 40.5% decrease

Total charges 28.1% decrease

"A percentage in crime reduction of this magnitude is remarkable and validates the effort within the partnership between Police and the YOUCAN Youth Services **Relentless** Youth Outreach team. This is a long-term solution to reducing violent crime in Edmonton and improving the lives of our community members.

"Edmonton Police Service in partnership with YOUCAN Youth Services aims to balance support and enforcement with prevention, intervention, and suppression that will interrupt violence and gang activity. The statistics shown in the year end and mid-year reports substantiate that police alongside our community partners must invest in our youth. It takes time to build relationships and treat the cause rather than the symptom. We are confident that the **Relentless** model is changing the lives of our young people and making an impact on our community."

## EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMMING

#### Earn While You Learn!

All youth in our employment programs earn a \$15/hour allowance/wage subsidy while attending our in-house trainings.

#### **VERTO PROGRAM**

The Verto Project (Verto is Latin for "turn-around" or "change") is a unique pre-employment program that assists youth between the ages of 18-25 transition out of harm's way and back into school or into the workforce. Twelve youth are accepted into each Intake, with a new project beginning every 9 weeks.

The Verto Project runs Monday to Friday from 9am - 4pm. During the first nine weeks of program, youth will participate in employment development, personal development, technology training, conflict resolution, wellness training, volunteerism, leadership development, and being **Relentless**. During the final two weeks of the program, youth will experience intensive employment readiness training and receive certification in First Aid and may have the opportunity to access other employment related safety certifications if needed.

The Verto Project gives youth the skills that are necessary to transition back into school or employment and away from the harmful lifestyles they are currently living by supporting them in a **Relentless** way to find success and independence.

Employment is the goal for the youth attending the project, with schooling as an option to achieve the employment goals set by the youth themselves. Participants will also be attached to a **Relentless** Transitional Outreach Worker to support with the transition into meaningful employment.

#### VERTO PROJECT 2022/2023 HIGHLIGHTS

70 youth entered the 6 intakes that were implemented.

94% (66 youth) completed the 9- week in-house portion of the program and transitioned into the 12-week employment opportunity phase.

77% (54 youth) secured and maintained employment

4% (3 youth) registered and were accepted into post-secondary/upgrading/further training

#### ROAD TO WORK PROGRAM

The Road to Work Program is designed to support youth to get the skills and safety trainings necessary to enter the construction, road work, and traffic safety sectors. Through partnerships between YOUCAN Youth Services and these construction industries, youth will have a direct route from training to employment.

The Road to Work Program will deliver workshops and industry focused safety trainings to successful candidates, aged 18-25 years old, giving them the tools necessary to be ready to show up to the work site. Twelve youth are accepted into each Intake, with a new intake beginning every five to six weeks during March to September. The in-house programming portion is implemented over five weeks and runs Monday to Friday from 9am – 4pm.

Upon completion of the training portion of the program, participants will be supported in a Relentless way to apply for employment with one of the program's industry partners in the construction, road building, and traffic safety industries. Participants will also be attached to a **Relentless** Transitional Outreach Worker to support with the transition into meaningful employment.

2% (1 youth) registered and were accepted into post-secondary/upgrading/further training

A notable achievement is the smooth transition of participants from training to employment. Employer partnerships eliminate barriers, facilitating a direct route to practical application. Skilled youth seamlessly contribute to the growth of many industries while being supported by a Relentless Transitional Youth Outreach Worker.

#### COMMITMENT TO ENHANCING OPPORTUNITIES

The journey of the Road to Work Program has seen remarkable progress. Our **Relentless** commitment to skill development, safety training, and collaborations has transformed lives and added to the trade's workforce. Moving ahead, we are dedicated to shaping brighter futures and fostering industry growth through collaboration and education.

#### EMPOWERING TRANSFORMATIONS

Over the past year, the Verto Project has made improvements in empowering young people in a **Relentless** way to embrace positive changes. Their journeys blend skill development, personal growth, and practical application. This equips participants to leave harmful situations and embark on paths toward meaningful employment or education.

#### **OUTCOME-CENTRIC APPROACH**

YOUCAN Youth Services promise is its **Relentless** commitment to tangible outcomes. The past year witnessed numerous success stories, validating the structured curriculum, mentoring, and support systems. Participants transitioned from instability to stable employment or education. The outcomes speak for themselves.

#### STRENGTHENING COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

Strategic collaborations with community organizations, educational institutions, employment partners, fundraising partners, donors, and Government expanded our reach and impact. These partnerships are essential for sustainable transformation and a robust support network for our youth.

#### RELENTLESS YOUTH OUTREACH WORKERS EFFORTS YIELDED RESULTS

Youth-related disruptions and crime significantly decreased with enhanced attendance in school, programs, and employment. The **Relentless** Youth Outreach Workers mitigated harm by assisting in reduced risk factors in our youth and their families and boosting protective and success factors.

#### ONGOING RELENTLESS COMMITMENT

Reflecting on the journey from April 2022 to March 2023, YOUCAN Youth Services has lived up to its name by catalyzing change in the lives of the young people we serve. Team dedication, participant resilience, stakeholder support, and being **Relentless** fuel this change. Our unwavering commitment persists, guiding young adults toward safe and more secured futures. 
